- At most one course in the minor, including prerequisite courses.

**Transfer Credit**

At most, two transfer credits may be counted toward the major, modified major, or minor; subject to approval by the Chair and the Registrar. Transfer credit cannot be used to satisfy the advanced seminar (PHIL 50) and culminating experience seminar (PHIL 80) requirements.
